

Constitution of the Body

1. The **Canada Data Centres' Alliance (CDCA)** is a distinguished and professionally governed group dedicated to advancing the interests of the Canadian data centre and digital infrastructure sector. The Alliance is committed to fostering collaboration, sharing best practices, promoting innovation, and supporting sustainable development within the industry. 2. **Governing Structure**
